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Food Safety Training Class for Food Handlers

This 1 & 1/2 hour introductory course covers the basics of Safe Food Handling, Dangers of Foodborne Illness, Personal Health & Hygiene and Temperature Control. This course is recommended for 25% food handlers (wait staff, bartenders, cooks, deli workers and dishwashers) on duty at any given time. There is no fee to attend this class. Please register one week in advance of the class dates.

Food Safety Training Class for Managers

This 4 hour course will give managers the knowledge needed to reduce the risk of spreading foodborne illness and comply with the requirements of the Missouri Food Code. There is no fee to attend this class. Please register one week in advance of the class dates.

*** Effective July 1, 2010, Johnson County requires that all Managers and 25% of food handlers have documentation of approved food safety program certification.**

*** The food safety training classes offered by JCCHS are recognized by other Missouri Health Departments (KCMO, Independence, Jackson County & Henry County) and vice versa. Check with the appropriate agency about whether additional documentation or fees are required.**

*** Please register one week in advance of the manager and handler food safety training classes.**
