HOW TO APPLY:

—————
Mother must be at least 35 weeks gestation, or no more than 3 months postpartum.

—————
Application must be completed. Eligibility determined by need as listed on application

—————
If eligible to receive a crib, must agree to a home visit. Information will be provided on crib set up and safe sleep during initial interview. The crib will be delivered approximately 2 weeks from initial interview. In-home visit will occur 4-6 weeks after delivery of crib.
