Food Safety Training

This course covers the basics of safe food handling, dangers of foodborne illness, personal health & hygiene and temperature control along with the knowledge needed to reduce the risk of spreading food borne illness and to comply with the requirements of the MO Food Code This course is required for 25% of food handlers (wait staff, bartenders, cooks, deli workers and dishwashers) on duty at any given time. There is no fee to attend this class.

Reminder: All food managers must have a food safety certificate.

Classes may be cancelled due to weather and low registration. Please register one week in advance of the food safety training classes.



Wash your hands and use a utensil, clean glove or a napkin to handle food to prevent contamination of Norovirus, Hepatitis A, *Shigella*, *Salmonella* Typhi, *Escherichia coli*, *Staphylococcus aureus*.
